Title: **MIGRANT TALENT GARDEN**

Short Description

The Migrant Garden project was born to help migrants to find a job, working around multiple barriers such as poor linguistic skills and unfamiliar social, economic and legal frameworks, through a pragmatic approach which makes it easy to translate ideas into practice; the document is structured in two parts: the first including an analysis of 21 good practices, 18 study visits, a survey and interviews with 15 migrants, and the second part presenting guidelines to follow in order to create a business hub with an incubation program of 24 months for non-EU entrepreneurs, with the aim to develop strategies and to improve competences through training, thus boosting the creation of new businesses in order to reduce unemployment amongst migrants.

Short Description

MigrEmpower is an Erasmus project aiming to support migrants and refugees in the process of inclusion and to promote a better coexistence in their respective host communities. Six UE countries have conceived and structured methodological and useful interventional tools to the operators working in the welcoming sector, so that they can launch with migrants a path focused on orientation, competence assessment, self-evaluation, and empowerment. A manual of orientation and evaluation was written and an educational path for the enhancement of social, interpersonal and of active citizenship skills was created, applying non-formal techniques with a focus on team building, active listening and clear interaction. In addition to acquiring new knowledge on active citizenship, migrants will learn how to apply it in their current context, for instance through volunteering and through supporting communities, developing problem-solving and conflict-resolution skills and, moreover, increasing their chances to find a job.

Short Description

Migrant and refugees were involved in the process of putting this guide into writing - through real-life meeting in which they narrated their struggles with the process of inclusion - with the aim of creating including and inviting multi-cultural “welcoming environments”. The booklet includes ready-made flexible activities sharing the common focus of integration through various methods – e.g.: environmental education; the creation of a welcoming culture; the creation of an inclusive global justice movement; the building of communities. For instance, the workshops aim to create awareness in regard to energy consumption; discovering nature, also as a space that connects people; providing migrants with the opportunity to share their culture, traditions and religion with locals; reflecting on climate justice, and environmental issues in order to form members of a healthy society.
