Short Description

Migrant Literacies is an Erasmus+ KA2 project focused on the development of innovative practices in the field of adult education, specifically concerning media and digital literacy (including the creative use of ICT for language learning) and creation of new tools for improving teachers and mediators job in the education of adult migrants. With the development of national toolkits for the teaching of Literacy and Digital Literacy to migrants, the project develops multiple learning paths, embedded in the national contexts of the project partner countries, providing so innovative tools for Educators and Teachers working in the field. For this, the project foresees the experimentation with migrants students. As educators working with adult migrants are often a kind of migrants themselves – *digital migrants* – the objective of the project is to train educators working in the field of adult education, develop their media and digital literacy competencies through a MOOC that explores the potentials of innovative and creative uses of ICT and Media in the effective teaching of Literacy to migrant adults. MOOC is made by videos, activities and background information on various topics such as the importance of multiple literacies, why using ICT in language learning, data privacy, and App usage, the potentials of using mobile media and the use of digital technologies for the empowerment of learners.
